CATERING PITCH TENDER 2022

The closing date for this tender is 1st March 2022.

The following document is to tender for a Catering Pitch at the Boconnoc Steam Fair. As from this point, Boconnoc steam fair will be known as the Club and the company providing the catering service will be known as the Supplier. The payment between the Club and the Supplier will be agreed prior to the event (payment due in full at least Supplier to the Club on signing any contract).

The catering establishment must be self-contained within a towed vehicle or erected enclosure. Any erected structure must be covered by approved insurance suitable for event purpose. The Supplier will provide a copy of the insurance policy of the equipment and/or structure and Food Hygiene Rating Certificate to the Club prior to the event. A menu must be sent to the Club prior to the event. Food availability must cover Friday, Saturday & Sunday of the event up until at least 5pm on each of the days.

The Supplier will have the right to provide food/drink after 5pm period. All personnel must be trained to the required standards. The Supplier will be responsible for obtaining all the correct licenses for the event, the serving area must be of size that will not cause undue delays or overcrowding. The Supplier will be responsible for cleaning up all rubbish in and adjacent to their serving area and will ensure that ALL cardboard boxes are suitably crushed before placing in the bins. The Supplier will provide their own power generation - if this is a generator this must be suitably earthed.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY BOCONNOC STEAM FAIR

1. The Owners and Drivers of the exhibit must be covered by a current third-party insurance policy, including exhibitor use. A copy of which **MUST** be submitted with this entry form.
2. Owners must ensure drivers are fully competent and have a valid and appropriate licence and be qualified to drive or handle the exhibit.
3. No exhibit may be left running unattended and if unattended **MUST** be left securely 'braked and immobilized.
4. All working exhibits must be in a safe working condition.
5. The **MAXIMUM** speed of **5MPH** shall apply to all moving vehicles on the site or any part of the Boconnoc Estate. Any exhibitor found to be exceeding the speed limit will be asked to leave forthwith.
6. All owners and drivers must obey Marshall's instructions and not inconvenience or endanger any persons or animals on the site or any part of the Boconnoc estate.
7. Owners are responsible for their own personal effects for which the organizers will take no responsibility.
8. All Trade stand, Auto jumble, Craft and other stalls or stands must be covered by Public Liability insurance. A copy of which **MUST** be sent with entry form.
